From the Pastor's Pen

Dear friends,

I saw a guitar pic the other day that had on it, "I Pick You". Very fun.

But here's the thing, when it comes to faith – is it us picking Jesus or Jesus picking us? Jesus picks us. Luther wrote about it this way in the 3rd article definition of the Apostles' creed: "I believe that by my own understanding or strength I cannot believe in Jesus Christ... or come to him... the Holy Spirit has called me through the gospel...and kept me in the true faith."

We can reject God, we often choose to sin, knowing right from wrong, but we cannot 'decide' to believe – this is the gift of the Holy Spirit; we come to faith, through hearing of God's word, through prayer, through seeking, but it is the Holy Spirit that brings us to faith, to believe in what we cannot see or touch or taste – Our Lord Jesus Christ.

I love the song "I Have Decided to Follow Jesus", but it is theologically wrong; correct only in that I can choose to do right or wrong, but not faith. Faith comes by the Holy Spirit working in us, sanctifying us, helping us lead a godly life, empowering us to have faith.

Brent was a bully. He lied and cheated and used people. He was never content. Desperate one day to change his life, he reached out to an old friend, who told him about sin and Jesus had lived and died a cruel death to pay for those sins he had committed so often. The Holy Spirit opened Brent's heart to hear these words and started working in him the change he longed for. It wasn't long thereafter that Brent confessed Jesus as his Lord and was baptized. With the guidance of the Spirit and his friend he started to make changes in his life. Jesus 'picked' him, and he began to pick the right behavior and paths. This perhaps is evidence of the Spirit's presence.

<u>Galatians 5: 22-25</u>: But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control... Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

- *Bible Verse: It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Galatians 5:1
- *Activity: Painted salt fireworks. Need: black paper, white glue, table salt, water color paint or food coloring, cookie sheet. Place paper on cookie sheet. Using the glue, design your firework, while glue is still wet sprinkle with salt generously. Gently shake salt off onto tray or newspaper. Dilute paint so it will be very wet on brush and carefully touch the salt (don't drag brush). This can be done while glue is still wet or after it has dried. If using food dye, dilute in a cup and use a paint brush or eye dropper to color salt.
