Ramp Hill Project Update

The ramp hill project was approved at the May 2021 congregational meeting. The design is absolutely beautiful, there are pictures of what it will look like in the narthex. It has a white block wall with "Trinity Lutheran Church" letters on it and a sitting or picture taking area on top. This design is low maintenance and will eliminate the hazardous grass mowing of the steep slope. It will automatically water direct to each plant and will light the new rail and step design. It also replaces the worn concrete steps.

This new design faces the town park and will be a "call to worship" to park attendees and all who drive by and see it. It will also enhance our church building. We are promoting this through a fund raiser that allows you to donate at different cost levels that work with your budget. You can give as many as you like, examples are: Adopt a white wall block, \$75**a church name letter, \$75**a rock, \$50**a paver brick, \$10

The Endowment committee has pledged to match your gift up to \$5,000 which doubles the amount you donate. The Ladies fall harvest dinner on November 2nd will designate the proceeds to this project. You can designate your Kwik Trip reward dollars and the Raise Right gift card program dollars to the ramp hill project but <u>you need to let Amy in the office know</u>.
