Dear friends,

- *November 3rd @7pm: Youth ELCA Trip meeting (downstairs).
- **★Don't forget** to pick up SS lessons for home if not attending in-person.
- **★Bible Verse**: Isaiah 49:16 'The Lord said, "I have inscribed you on the **palms** of My hands".'
- *Activity: Sand/Clay Handprint Keepsake/gift: Need: 2 Cups of sand, 1 ½ C plain flour, 1 C warm water, 1 ¼ C salt. Mix sand, flour and salt in a large bowl; slowly add water. Note, if it feels a bit too sticky add a bit more flour or sand. Optional items: shells, pebbles, etc. Makes up to 4 small hands worth. Separate dough into 3-4 balls (1 per child). On a lightly floured baking sheet roll out dough to about ½ inch think or less. Push child's hand into the center, making sure each finger is pushed firmly. Lift off carefully. Decorate with shells. Bake in oven at 250° for 4 hours, longer if thicker. If hard on the top but not underneath, take them out and gently turn them over, then put them back into the oven for another hour or two to harden the underside. From: theimaginationtree.com.
