January 2024 From the Pastor's Pen

Dear friends.

Well, another year is upon us. Where did July go? How time flies... So, did you accomplish your resolutions from last year? Or are they going to be revisited this year? If you are making resolutions, make sure they are realistic, not like: "I'm going to be a better person". How specifically would you do this? Be specific: I am going to take cooking lessons or learn Excel. I will attend an anger management course. I will try a new hair cut... Instead of "I'm going to lose 75 pounds"; it is more genuine to set a goal of: "I will exercise 2 times a week using XYZ video" or "I will take at least one 15-minute walk on Tuesdays." It is easier to accomplish realistic goals versus pie in the sky kind of objectives.

What about spiritual goals? What might you add or change there? Can you add devotion time? If you aren't already, consider adding the weekly emailed devotion here from the church or picking up one of our free devotion books – then plan when and where you will read it. Already doing this? Consider other forms of meditation. Perhaps go to YouTube and search 'Christian guided meditation', such as the 5 minute ones from Alabaster Co. These are wonderful when you are feeling stressed.

I personally love the 'Christian dance workouts' by <u>Joyful Praise Fitness</u>. Each session is about 4 uplifting songs (158 minutes) to get me moving, and I can pause it if I need a break. The first goal was to do at least 1 song per week for one month, and then to work up to all the songs in the session. There is so much out there; *just be selective as to the source of videos you watch*.

Have you tried a prayer journal or a Gratitude journal? This would be a good year to start if you are not already trying this. Also one of the best ways to deepen our relationship with God, along with Bible reading, prayer and devotions is memorizing Bible verses, maybe one a month or one a week. Write a verse on a post-it or index card and put it where you will see it (bathroom mirror). Here's some suggestions to get you started for this New Year:

John 3:16: For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18: Rejoice always, pray without ceasing, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.
