Personal Note: I am working on getting stronger. Brain fog is still an issue, but it is improving. JoHanna continues working as a traveling CNA.



**UPDATE**: As you read this the ramp hill concrete wall may be poured. It is exciting to finally see this project begin. The warm weather is allowing us to get an early start. We expect this will take several months to complete with weather permitting. Please be patient.

The handicap doors at the top of the ramp will not be accessible during construction. We will attempt to keep the fellowship hall doors available for wheel chair access. You will need to back your vehicle down the ramp after drop off and pick up of your passenger. We also have a stair lift at the west lower level entrance.



The project has raised over \$57,000 so far and the total cost of phase one will be about \$100,000. The congregation has approved a loan for up to \$50,000. These dollars do not include phase two for the canopy, but, does include the footings for it. Please help us raise the balance of funds.
