Ramp Hill Update:

We are still waiting for the step and patio rails to be installed. We hope these are done before the Rally day dedication on September 8th. We will dedicate the phase I portion consisting of a beautiful wall and rock replacement of the steep hill We also addressed the repair of the roof water drainage, handicap door settling, and the step deterioration while the construction equipment was on site.

We continue to receive weekly funding towards this project. We have received around \$600 towards 13 of the twenty patio LED lights at \$82.50 each. This means we have paid for over half of the lights needed. We also need at least seven more lights for the seat wall lighting of the sidewalk below the wall. Thank you for these gifts!

We still need to sell 418 square feet of face stone at a best offer of our \$2,000 investment. We also have the left over 282 Brand Wine king size bricks for sale at .65 each or a total of \$183.30 or best offer. This is also income when sold. Contact Glenn Quinnell at 608-547-7895 if interested. We can deliver.

The total expense for this phase is around \$104,000 and we have funded over \$60,000. We also have a loan of \$50,000 with members committed to giving around \$470 per month for loan payments. Your additional help with commitments or gifts will pay off this loan at a faster rate. The ramp hill committee continues to **thank you** for your gifts and support.

★ Activity: Make baked apple slices together! Preheat the oven to 350 & Grease a large baking dish with butter. Ingredients. 2 Tbsp brown sugar. 3 tsp white sugar.3 tsp cinnamon (to taste). 1 tsp ground nutmeg (to taste). 6 large apples – (peeled optional) cored, & sliced. 3 ½ Tbsp water. Mix together dry ingredients. Put a layer of apple slices (bout 1/3rd) in the buttered baking dish & sprinkle with 1/3 of the sugar mixture; repeat the layering and sprinkling. Bake for 30 minutes; pour water over the apples & bake an additional 15 minutes. Serve warm. Great with ice cream!

Cranberry Cherry Pie by Marge Waller (from Recipes & Memories Cookbook)

(Serves 6-8) 3/4 c. sugar

2 Tbsp. cornstarch

2 c. cranberries (frozen or fresh) Pastry for double-crust pie Milk and additional sugar for crust 1 21-oz can cherry pie filling



Combine sugar and cornstarch. Stir in pie filling and cranberries. Pour filling into lined 9" pie plate. Roll out remaining pastry, cut slits in pastry. Place pastry over filling. Seal and flute edges. Brush with milk and sprinkle on sugar.

Bake at 375° for 55-60 minutes or until crust is golden brown. Cool on wire rack.
