Dear Friends.

I hope your summer so far is a great one, that you have taken opportunities to enjoy the sunshine and relax in the shade, maybe sit by a campfire and hear it crackling. I personally have enjoyed meeting with the youth of our church over the summer

I was going through confirmation work and was thinking about the vocabulary we use in our faith life, words like Amen, Selah, grace, mercy, blessing even: Amen is an affirmation, stating that you agree with what was just said or prayed. It also means you are asking God to make that statement or prayer happen. Sometimes in the Psalms you will see the word Selah, which we are not sure actually what it means, is often used as a pause in the reading, like a sigh.

As for grace, mercy and blessings, I remember reading somewhere: Grace is when God gives us good things that we don't deserve, Mercy is when God spares us from bad things we do deserve and Blessings are when God is generous with both – grace and mercy. God is merciful and gracious – I am so thankful! Amen!! Selah. (Let me know if there's another word that you would like me to address.)



# Abbreviated Unapproved Council Meeting Minutes for July 7, 2025

**Present:** Sandy Willis, Mike Willis, Dana Henriksen, Carrie Easterly, Garret Gould, Pastor Terri Skildum. Absent: Liz Hendricksen, excused, Gretchen Wetzel, excused, Leif Pedersen, excused, Cathy Westover, excused.

The meeting was called to order at 5:40 p.m. by President Garret Gould, with a quorum present.

**Approve agenda:** The agenda was amended to add under New Business: 2. Lions flag discussion. A motion to approve the amended agenda made by Carrie Easterly, second by Mike Willis. Carried.

**Opening Devotions:** Pastor read from Corinthians, Galatians, and Psalm 131. All were about Christians living in unity and allowing all parts to contribute-for both individuals and as a whole body of Christ. Followed by prayer.

**Approve June Council Meeting Minutes:** Motion to approve the minutes made by Carrie/Mike Willis. Carried. **Approve June Treasurer's Report:** In absence of the Treasurer the Year to Date Budget was reviewed.

**Pastor's Report:** Visits in last 6 weeks: 11; At Rest: 1; At the Altar: no weddings scheduled. New members will be received on July 20, 2025; At the Font: 1 upcoming in August; Other: Rev. Shelley Nelson will be our guest Pastor on July 20. Council needs to be alert to locking up the building. We will take a free-will offering on Sunday, July 13 for victims in Texas.

### Old Business:

- \* Wi/Fi phones update: nothing new
- \* Doorbell/Ring Service: Cannot seem to get security camera to connect to the Wi/Fi. Will seek advice from tech people.
- \* Servant Keeper: has been purchased and installed
- \* Pastor's new computer: has been purchased and arrived.
- \* Church Long Range Plan: still in progress
- \* Pastor Terri will be gone July 20, 2025
- \* Chip Sealing: contract was signed
- \* Update Committee Liaisons: (Finance and Personnel): Finance: (audit and review) members are Cathy Westover, Liz Hendricksen, Robin Hansen. Personnel: members are Dana Henriksen, and Gretchen Wetzel.

## **New Business:**

- \* Loan considerations for Solar Project: Garret checked with several banking institutions. 1. Mission Investment: offers 8.875% interest, uninsured loan, some closing costs on a loan of \$45,000. 2. Royal Bank: \$50,000 loan: 7% interest, no bank fees, no prepayment penalty. Payments: Lock 5 yrs/ Am 10 yrs= \$580.84 at 7%. Lock 5 yrs/ Am 15yrs= \$4449.41 at 7%. \$45,000 loan: 5/10 = \$552.49; 5/15 = \$404.47. A motion was made by Dana Henriksen to proceed with Royal Bank, seconded by Mike Willis. Carried. Garret will proceed with the loan application.
- \* Lions flag discussion: The Lions Club will put out flags 5 times a year for \$40/flag. They will install a pipe to insert the pole in the ground and will place and remove the flags. After discussion it was decided to table any action until the Congregational Meeting to get congregation input.

- \* Outreach: The 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade entry was a success thank you to the Easterly's for their assistance!

- \* Worship Ministry: will meet July 13, 2025, after worship
- \* TLCW: the next meeting will be held August 17, 2025.

The meeting was adjourned at  $6:07\ p.m.$  closing with the Lord's Prayer.

**<u>Lemon Basil Chicken</u>** The Bible doesn't specifically mention basil. but it does garlic, onion and chicken. © Numbers 11:5 'We remember the fish we used to eat in Egypt for nothing, the cucumbers, the melons, the leeks, the onions, and the garlic.'

# Ingredients:

1 ½ pounds boneless, skinless chicken breasts, cut into 3/4-inch pieces (pre-cooked, shredded chicken can be used, such as from Kwik Trip)

½ yellow onion (finely chopped, about 1 cup)

4 cloves garlic (minced)

1/4 tsp black pepper

5 c. baby spinach leaves (about 5 ounces)

2 c. fresh Basil leaves

1 Tbsp olive oil

2 Tbsp soy sauce

1 Tbsp lemon zest 2 Tbsp lemon juice (freshly squeezed)

salt and pepper to taste

Directions: In a large skillet, heat the olive oil over medium. Add the onion and cook, stirring often, until softened, about 4 minutes. Add the garlic and cook until fragrant, about 30 additional seconds. Add the chicken, increase the heat to medium high, and let cook for 3 minutes, browning all sides. Stir in the soy sauce and black pepper. Let cook until the chicken is completely cooked through, about 3 minutes longer. Stir in the spinach a few handfuls at a time, letting the heat of the pan wilt it as you go. Stir in the lemon zest, lemon juice, and basil. Cook and stir just until the basil is wilted, about 1 additional minute. Taste and season with additional salt or pepper as desired. Serve warm with rice as desired.



# 7-Up Salad


