Our fiscal year is soon coming to a close, and our finance committee will draft next year's budget. Now is a good time to consider what Trinity Church in Arkdale means to you. Think about all the programs and ministries that you love and would like to support and how you can get involved.

Ramp Hill Loan Update

The ramp hill loan is gradually getting paid off. The principal amount owed is \$30,957.65. This is after the January congregational meeting approved a budget to pay \$15,800 ASAP in advance to save interest money. This money was budgeted in anticipation of income. We continue to make a \$400 payment each month and estimate about half of that is principal.

We continue to receive income each month from those who committed to helping make the payments several years ago when we did a survey. We are also receiving some gifts in memory of loved ones or people just trying to help pay off the loan. We did sell the excess stone and brick for \$1600. Income in excess of the \$400 payment is returned to the general budget to pay back the anticipated \$15,800 paid in advance. Total receipts including the \$1,600, are \$6,875.57 as of 9/23/25. This means we still need \$8,924.43 to meet the budget expense for 2025.

Many would like to move forward to building the canopy. This was estimated to cost about \$40,000 and the ramp hill was designed to accommodate this project. Please keep the loan and the canopy in mind when designating your project gifts to the church.


